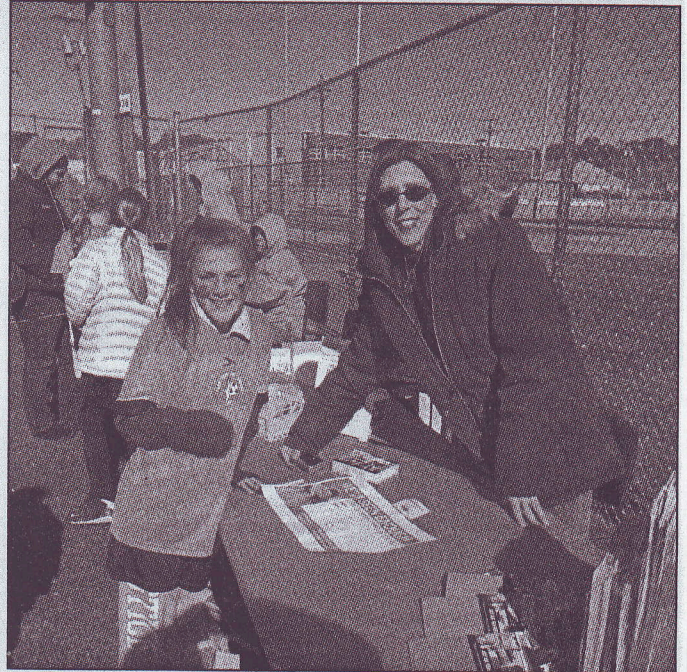

As the soccer games were underway, Glen Cove residents could stop by the tables and speak to local doctors, service providers, and representatives from local agencies that promote healthy bodies and minds.

PRIDE Coalition volunteers disseminated over 400 backpacks, containing prevention literature, PRIDE bracelets,

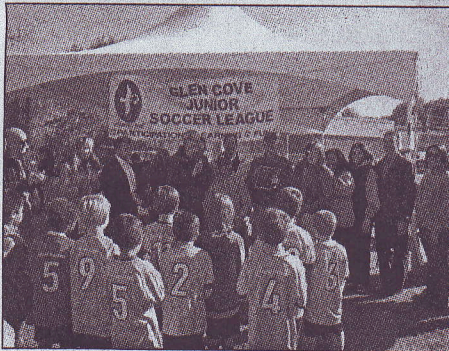
